The Assessment Council meeting of the Kania School of Management was held Thursday, 4/14/05, at 11:30 a.m. in Brennan Hall 314.

Paul opened the meeting and passed out an Assessment Mini Grant document – final version to be added to each individual Assessment Council binder.

Paul then proceeded to hand out a document on the articulation of relationship between goals of Kania School of Management and the University of Scranton. After some discussion of this document it was agreed upon that it should not be accepted as the final version. It was pointed out that it linked more to liberal arts and not enough to comprehensive characteristics. It was agreed upon to add an introductory sentence linking Kania School of Management to other aspects of the University.

Other handouts presented to all present were:

A lengthy discussion followed on the Kania School of Management Student Learning Goals and Objectives binder document. Paul explained that the objectives listed under each goal were only examples. It was decided that if at least one objective could be developed for each of the five undergraduate goals and one objective for each of the five MBA goals that would be a good start. Paul asked those present to think about these objectives and send them to him for review.

Before the meeting closed Paul handed out the Mgt 455 Writing Project results along with a graphic chart. Paul asked the members to review the results for discussion at the next meeting.

Paul would like to accelerate the meetings and possibly meet twice in May but due to schedules (dept. meetings, etc.) this may not be possible.
