Bio: Three-year letterman...has been a consistent scoring threat throughout his 78-game career...has 28 goals and 29 assists for 57 total points in his career...is

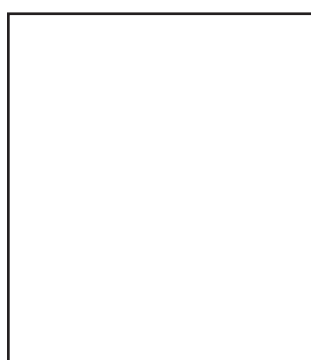
nine points shy of moving into the top 15 all-time in Scranton history...will serve as assistant captain for the 2008-2009 season...also lettered in men's lacrosse in 2006...**2007-2008 (Junior Year):** Saw action in all 27 games...tallied 11 goals and 15 assists--both career-highs...tied for second on the team in total points (26), finished second in assists (15), and third in goals (11)...accounted for at least one point in 16 games...had three multi-goal games: scored two goals in a 7-1 win over Villanova at home on October 21 and in a 6-5 loss at Navy on November 16, and had two goals and an assist in a 9-8 loss to Navy at home on January 12...scored at least one point in six straight games from October 6 through October 21; during that span, tallied five goals and six assists...scored a goal and finished with two assists in a 6-5 victory over Lehigh on February 9...scored Scranton's lone goal in an 8-1 loss at Navy in the opening round of the Eastern States Collegiate Hockey League playoffs on February 15...**2006-2007 (Sophomore Year):** Appeared in all 28 games...finished tied for third on the team in goals (8) and shots (62), fourth in total points (17), and tied for sixth in assists (9)...was also second in short-handed goals (2)...accounted for at least one point in 12 games...scored the game-winning goal during a shootout and added two assists in a 9-8 victory over Towson at home on January 7...scored four of his eight goals during a five-game period from October 20 through October 28, including one each in losses to then 20th-ranked Kent State, 9-1, and then 6th-ranked Michigan-Dearborn, 11-5, on October 20 and October 21, respectively, at the ACHA Showcase in Youngstown, Ohio...scored a short-handed goal at the 1-minute mark of the second period to give Scranton a 2-0 lead en route to a 6-2 victory over then 13th-ranked West Virginia at home on October 27...had two assists apiece in a 5-2 loss against Navy on October 8 and in a 7-6 loss in double overtime at Villanova on January 27...**2005-2006 (Freshman Year):** Appeared in 23 games...finished the season with nine goals and five assists for 14 total points...scored a season-high five goals, including the game-winner, and had an assist to finish with six total points in a 13-0 victory over Rutgers on November 5 at the Ice Box Sports Complex...scored at least one goal in five games and accounted for at least one total point in seven games.
