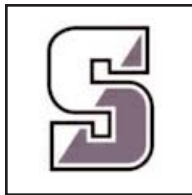

Swam in all 12 meets his freshman year...qualified for the Middle Atlantic Conference championships in the 200 breaststroke...majoring in pre-engineering...**2006-2007 (Freshman Year):** Swam six different events throughout the season...qualified for the MAC championships in

the 200 breaststroke and finished 15th in a season-best time of 2:29.28...posted runner-up finishes in the 100 breaststroke (1:08.79) and the 500 freestyle (6:18.28) in a 159-68 victory over Lycoming College on January 13 at the Byron Center...recorded a season-best time of 2:20.30 and finished second overall in a 97-79 win over Lebanon Valley on November 4 at the Byron Center.

Year): swam in all 12 meets...ended the season with three top-10 finishes at the Middle Atlantic Conference championships: placed fifth in the 200 back (2:02.87), sixth in the 100 back (:56.43) and seventh in the 200 individual medley (2:05.47)...all three of his times at the MAC championships were a season-best...was also a member of the 200 medley relay team that finished fourth in the MAC championships in a Royal record-breaking time of 1:40.07...posted eight first-place finishes in dual-meet competition...swam seven different events.

2005-2006 (Freshman Year): competed in 11 of 12 meets...set two Royal individual records at the MAC championships: swam a time of :55.51 in the preliminary of the 100 back (finished 4th overall with a finals time of :55.90) and a time of 2:01.26 to place third in the 200 back...teamed with the late Brendan Giblin, Joe Veselovsky and Ian Mullin to set new

Posted five first-place finishes in dual-meet competition...qualified for three events at the 2007 Middle Atlantic Conference championships and placed 11th in the 1650 freestyle (19:00.61), 11th in the 100 butterfly (:56.67) and 15th in the 200 individual medley (2:08.86)...his time in the 200 IM at the MAC championships was nearly 11 seconds faster than his time in the same event two weeks earlier against Misericordia...finished first in the 1000 free (11:32.21) and the 100 fly (:59.02) to help the Royals post a 62-37 victory over King's College in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, on January 9.
