Head Coach Mike Strong

Mike Strong continues to make the extraordinary look ordinary.

This past year, in his 26th season as head coach of The University of Scranton's women's basketball program, he led the Lady Royals to their eighth NCAA Division

III Final Four appearance in the program's history. His overall record of 639-132 (.829) includes 21 NCAA tournament appearances and 15 Middle Atlantic/Freedom Conference titles.

Consistency is Strong's best suit. He has led the Lady Royals to at least 20 wins in each of the last 15 seasons and 21 times overall. This accomplishment pales, however, in comparison to his NCAA Division III championship in 1985 or his seven other teams that reached the Final Four (1987, 1993, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2005, 2006). Overall, he has led Scranton to 21 NCAA tournament appearances and to 15 of the Lady Royals' 18 Middle Atlantic/Freedom Conference titles. He's never had a losing season, and the *fewest* victories he's ever posted in a year were 17.

He is second all-time in NCAA Division III women's basketball history with 639 wins.

An associate professor in the University's Exercise Science and Sport department, Mike and his wife Linda reside in Clarks Summit. The couple have two children, Scott and Chris, and three grandchildren.
