**Profile:** Four-year letter-winner...appeared in 64 games and started 36 times...finished her career with 49 ground balls, 24 draw controls and 32 caused turnovers...member

of three Middle Atlantic Conference tournament-qualifying teams (2005-2007) and an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) tournament-qualifying team (2005)...**2008 (Senior Year):** Started 13 of 15 games...recorded nine ground balls, nine caused turnovers, and three draw controls...member of a defensive unit that held seven opponents under 10 goals apiece...came up with three ground balls and caused two turnovers in a 13-7 victory over Moravian on April 5...also had two ground balls and caused two turnovers in a 9-8 victory over Widener on March 27...**2007 (Junior Year):** Played in all 15 games and started seven times...one of six Royal defenders with at least 10 ground balls...scooped up a season-high three ground balls in a win over Susquehanna (April 20)...also had two ground balls apiece in wins over Wilkes (April 4) and Widener (April 26)...finished tied for fifth on the team in caused turnovers with eight, including two each in a loss to Lycoming (March 29) and a win over Wilkes (April 4)...**2006 (Sophomore Year):** Started all 17 games as a defender...had 22 ground balls, 11 caused turnovers and seven draw controls...caused three turnovers in a 12-11 loss to Lycoming on March 28...came up with a season-high three ground balls apiece on four different occasions...key member of a defensive unit that held seven opponents to under 10 goals apiece...**2005 (Freshman Year)**...Appeared in all 17 games...came up with eight ground balls and six draw controls and caused four turnovers...had a season-high three ground balls in a 20-6 victory over Lycoming on March 16.

**Profile:** Two-year letter-winner...in 26 games, has tallied 47 goals and 26 assists for 73 total points...has scored three game-winning goals in her

career...is already tied for 10th-place on the Royals' all-time with 26 assists...has scored at least one goal in 20 games and has 12 multi-goal games...**2008 (Sophomore Year):** Returned to the lineup after missing the first five games of the season due to an injury and finished second on the team in goals (25) and third in total points (33)...tied her career-high with back-

to-back 5-goal performances in leading the Royals to wins over King's (14-6) and Misericordia (18-7) on April 14 and April 17, respectively...in her first game back from the injury, scored two goals, including the game-winner at the 60:20 mark of the overtime period, as the Royals downed Widener, 9-8, on March 27...also tallied the game-winning goal to cap off a 2-goal, 1-assist effort in a 13-4 win over Neumann on April 3...finished tied for fifth in game-winning goals, tied for seventh in points per game (3.0), tied for eighth in assists per game (0.88), and ninth in goals per game (2.27) in the final Landmark Conference statistical rankings...**2007 (Freshman Year):** Started all 15 games and led the Royals in assists (18), was third in total points (40), and fourth in goals (22)...tallied a career-high eight points on five goals and three assists in a dramatic double overtime victory against Susquehanna, 17-16, on April 20...scored at least one goal in 10 games and had five multi-goal games...tallied four goals, including the game-winner, and had an assist in an 18-13 win over Moravian on April 11...tied for third on the team in shot attempts with 60.

**Profile:** Two-year letter-winner...has been a valuable addition to the lineup as a key reserve up front throughout her career...has 12 goals and two

assists in 25 career games...**2008 (Sophomore Year):** Saw action in 14 games...finished the season with five goals (on 13 shot attempts) and had two assists for seven total points...tallied a career-high four points on two goals and two assists in a 19-4 victory over Alvernia on March 11...also contributed a goal in wins over Neumann (13-4), King's (14-6) and Misericordia (18-7)...scooped up 10 ground balls, including three apiece in wins over Alvernia and Misericordia...**2007 (Freshman Year):** Appeared in 11 games...attempted five of her 11 shots attempts en route to scoring a then season-high two goals in an 18-7 victory over Wilkes on April 4...tied that effort on April 26 by converting both of her shot attempts for goals in an 18-7 win over Widener...did see action in a 25-13 loss to Lycoming in the quarterfinals of the Middle Atlantic Conference tournament on May 1...three of her seven goals were scored on free positions: one each against Roger Williams on March 12, Wilkes, and King's on April 18...three of her six ground balls came in the first game of the season, a 14-12 loss to Roger Williams...was also credited with eight draw controls and six ground balls.
