**Profile:** Four-year letter-winner who started 61 of 63 games...consistent scoring threat up front who finished her career with 61 goals and 42 assists for 103 total points...is sixth in assists

and tied for ninth in total points in Scranton history...member of Middle Atlantic Conference tournament-qualifying teams (2005-2007)and ECAC Mid-Atlantic regional-qualifying team (2005)...**2008 (Senior Year):** Started all 16 games...scored 17 goals and had 14 assists to finish fourth on the team in scoring with 31 total points...scored at least one goal in 11 games and had five multi-goal games, including a three in a 13-11 loss to Susquehanna on April 9...opened the season with a 1-goal, season-high 4-assist performance in a 14-12 loss to Oneonta St. on March 8...had two goals and two assists in a 13-7 win over Moravian on April 5...**2007 (Junior Year):** Scored a career-best 19 goals and added 14 assists to finish fifth on the team in scoring with 33 total points...scored a career-high five goals and had two assists to finish with seven total points in an 18-13 victory over Moravian on April 11...scored at least one goal in 11 games and had four multi-goal games...finished third on the team in ground balls with 23, including four against Moravian...tallied three goals and an assist in a 17-16 win in double overtime against Susquehanna on April 20...**2006 (Sophomore Year):** Started 16 games...had 13 goals and and seven assists for 20 total points...also had 25 ground balls, 18 draw controls and six caused turnovers...scored at least one goal in 10 games and had three multi-goal games...accounted for at least one point in 11 games...tied her career-high of three points (2 goals and an assist) in a 17-8 victory over King's on May 2 in the quarterfinals of the Middle Atlantic Conference tournament...also scored two goals apiece in a 14-9 victory over Cabrini on March 13 and in an 11-10 loss to Drew on April 1...**2005 (Freshman Year):** Started 15 of 16 games...had 12 goals and seven assists for 19 total points...scored three goals in a 20-6 win over Lycoming on March 16 and accounted for three total points (2 goals, 1 assist) in a 17-6 loss to McDaniel in the ECAC tournament on May 14...scored at least one goal in seven games and had four multi-goal games...accounted for at least one point in nine games...also had 35 ground balls, 20 draw controls and five caused turnovers.

16 games and started 14 times...led all defenders and finished second on the team in ground balls with 28...scooped up a season-high four ground balls in an 11-10 overtime loss to St. Lawrence on March 19 and in a 14-6 win over King's on April 14...finished third on the team with 18 caused turnovers, including a career-high four against King's...**2007 (Freshman Year):** Appeared in and started 12 games...finished four on the team and led all defenders with 22 ground balls, including a career-high five in a 22-15 loss to Elizabethtown on April 14...scored the first goal of her career in an 18-7 win over Wilkes on April 4...registered the first assist of her career in an 18-13 win over Moravian on April 11...caused eight turnovers and came up with eight draw controls.
