

POST-GRADUATION ACTIVITIES CLASS OF 2005

The Career Services Office conducts an annual follow-up survey of The University of Scranton graduates to determine the post-graduation status of this population. This four-page publication serves as an executive summary of the survey findings. Actual placements with employers and graduate or professional schools can be identified in a full report available in the Career Services Office.

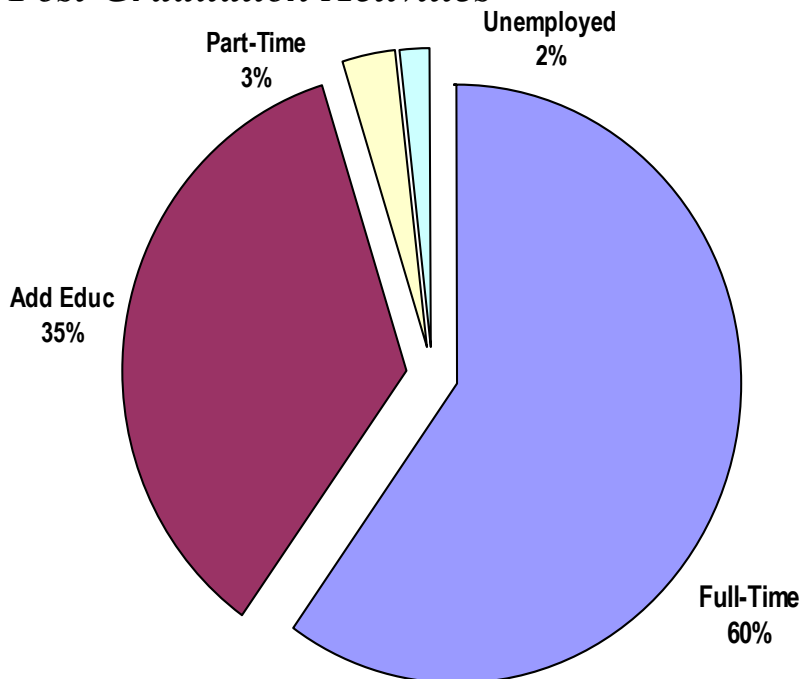
HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2005 REPORT

- 899 students completed baccalaureate degree requirements in 2005
- 75% (N=670) of the Class of 2005 provided placement information
- 95% of the respondents were either employed or pursuing additional education full-time
- 60% of the respondents were employed full-time
- The average salary reported for 2005 graduates was \$37,572, a 6.2% increase from the previous year
- 78% of the graduates employed full-time were working in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York
- 35% of the respondents were pursuing additional education full-time
- The unemployment rate for the Class of 2005 was 2%

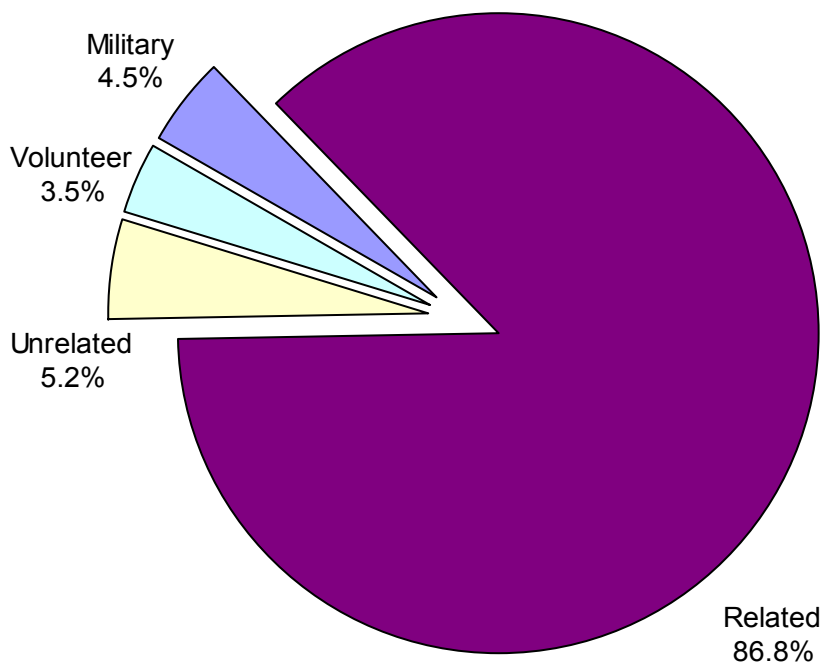
GRADUATES EMPLOYED FULL-TIME

Of the 404 graduates employed full-time, 86.8% were employed in occupations related to their academic major and 85% were working in Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York.

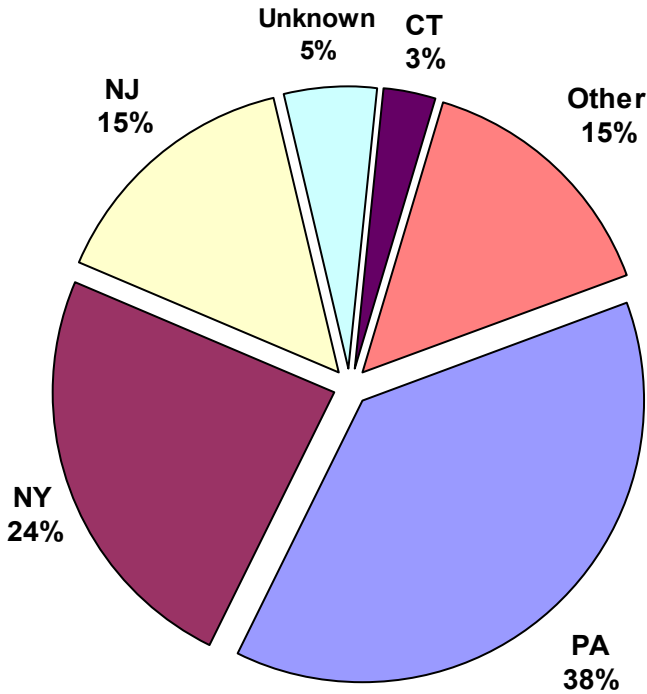
Post Graduation Activities



Breakdown of Full-Time Employment

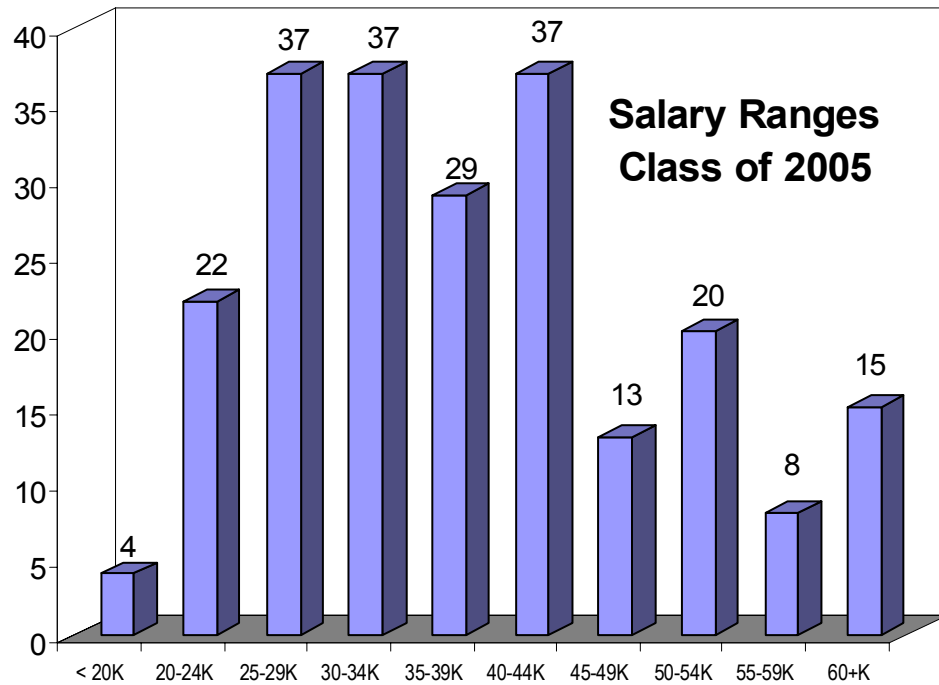


Geographical Placements by State



Salary Information

Approximately 55% of the graduates employed full-time provided salary information. The average salary for 2005 graduates was \$37,572 an 6.2% increase from 2004. Average salaries varied by type of job, location, and relatedness of work to academic preparation.



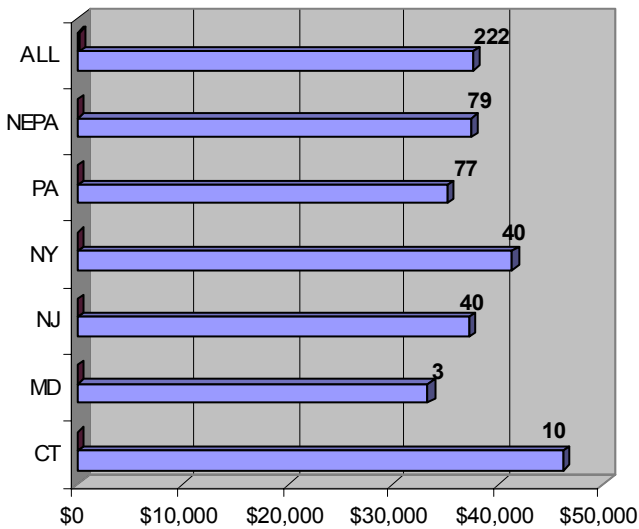

GRADUATES PURSUING ADDITIONAL EDUCATION

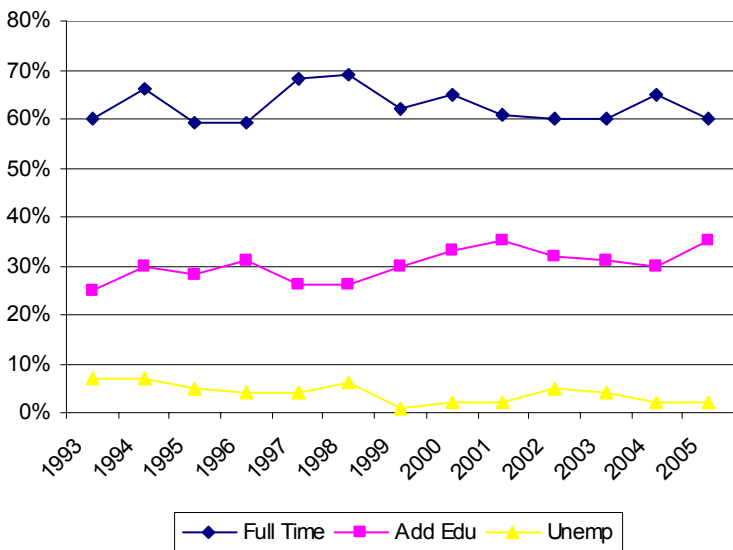
Two hundred and thirty seven graduates indicated they were pursuing additional education on a full-time basis. Based on responses from graduates of the Class of 2005, 24% were enrolled in Therapy related programs, 15% in Medicine related programs, 7% in Law, 11% in Counseling / Social Work programs, 5% in Science related programs, 10% in Business programs, and 14% enrolled in graduate Education programs.

Class of 2005 - Average Salaries by State

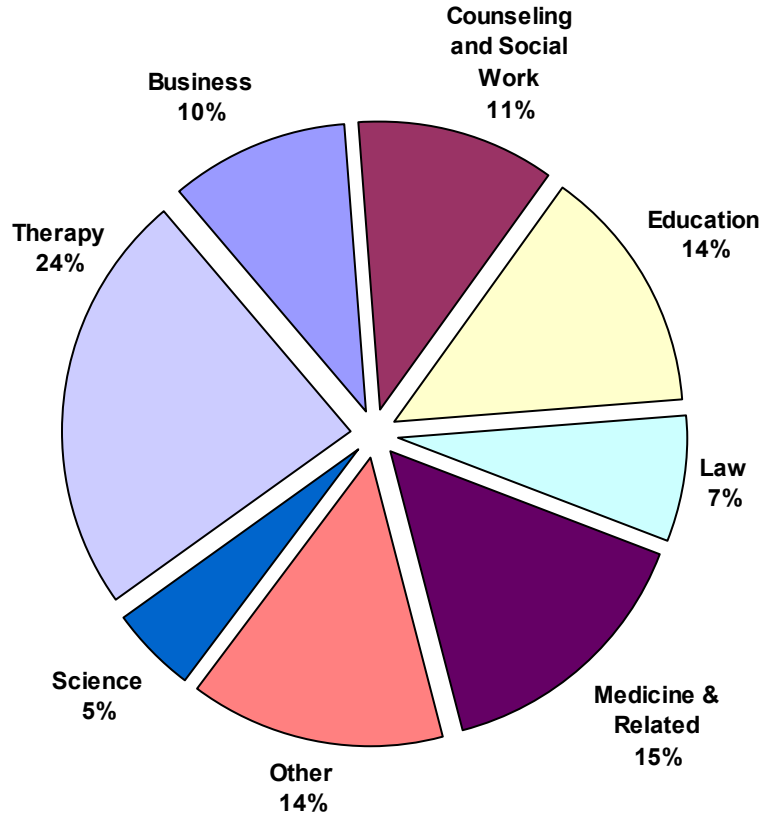

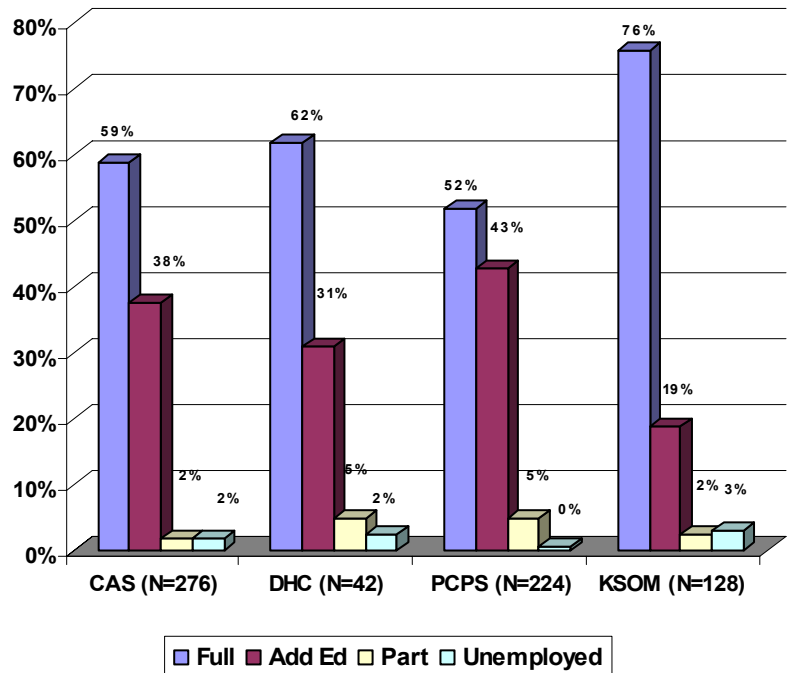
Post-Graduation Trends 1993-2005
