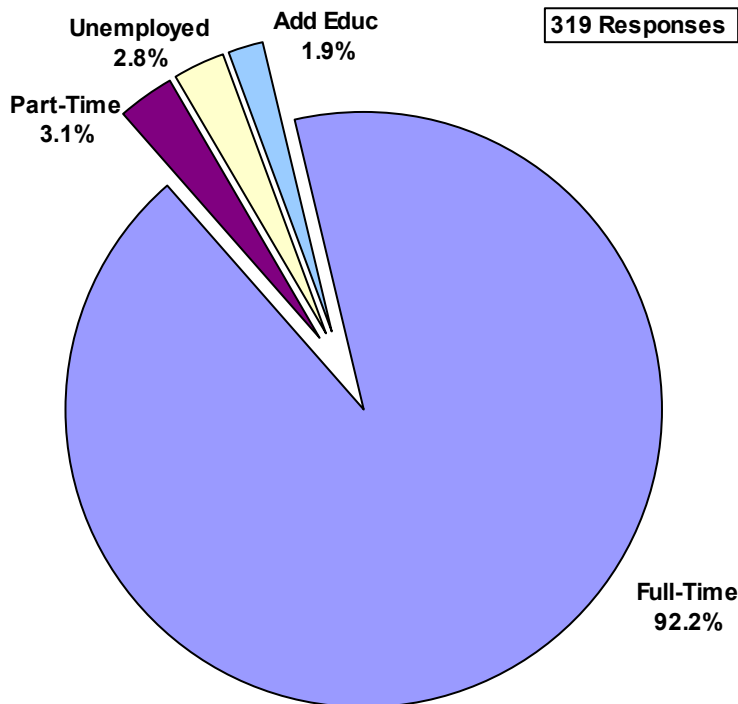


POST-GRADUATION ACTIVITIES

GRADUATE SCHOOL CLASS OF 2007

The Career Services Office conducts an annual follow-up survey of The University of Scranton graduates to determine the post-graduation status of this population. This four-page publication serves as an executive summary of the survey findings. Actual placements with employers and graduate or professional schools can be identified in a full report available in the Career Services Office.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2007 REPORT

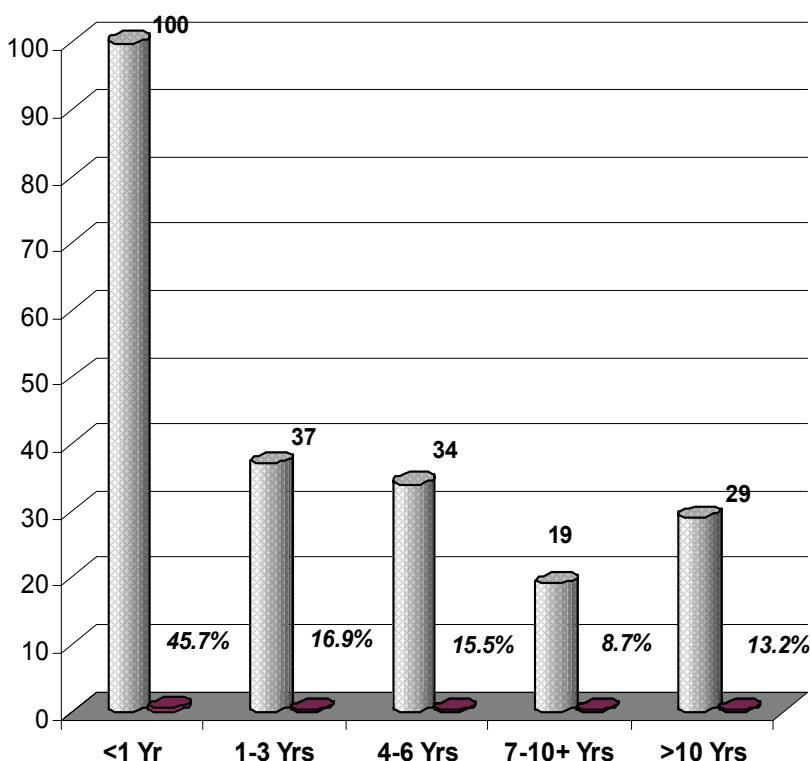
- 513 students completed graduate degree requirements in 2007; up from 320 in 2006
- New degree programs in Educational Administration and Curriculum and Instruction are primarily responsible for the increase; graduates from these programs created a wider distribution of placements in all reporting areas
- 62.2% (N=319) of the Class of 2007 provided placement information
- 97% of the respondents were either employed or pursuing additional education full-time
- 92% of the respondents were employed full-time
- The average salary reported for 2007 graduates was \$53,987. (222 salaries reported)
- 63.8% of the graduates employed full-time were working in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York
- 1.9% (N= 6) of the respondents were pursuing additional education full-time
- 45.7% of the graduates employed full-time are in jobs they have held for less than 1 year
- The unemployment rate for the Class of 2007 was 2.8%

Length of Time in Present Job

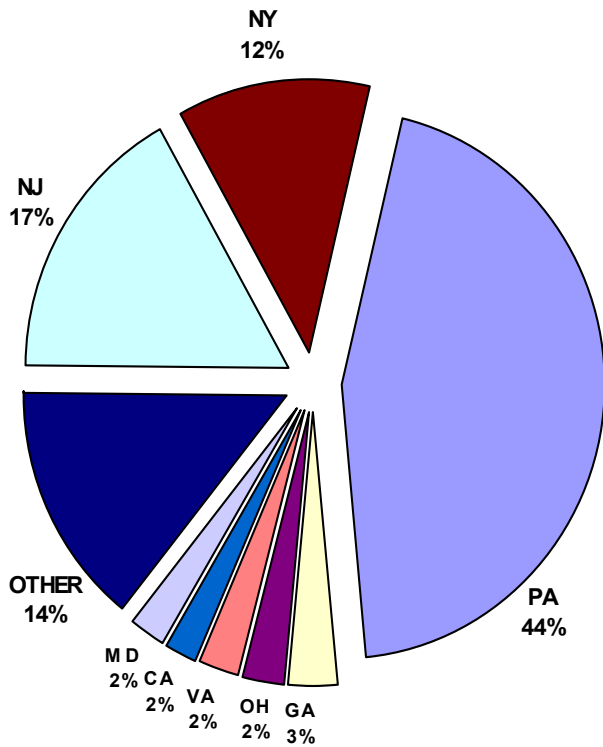
Approximately 45.7% of the graduates employed full-time indicated they were working in their job for less than 1 year. Nearly 28% of these graduates were Physical or Occupational Therapists.

A significant increase was seen in those reporting employment with more years of experience as a result of the new degree programs outlined above.

Length of Time in Present Job



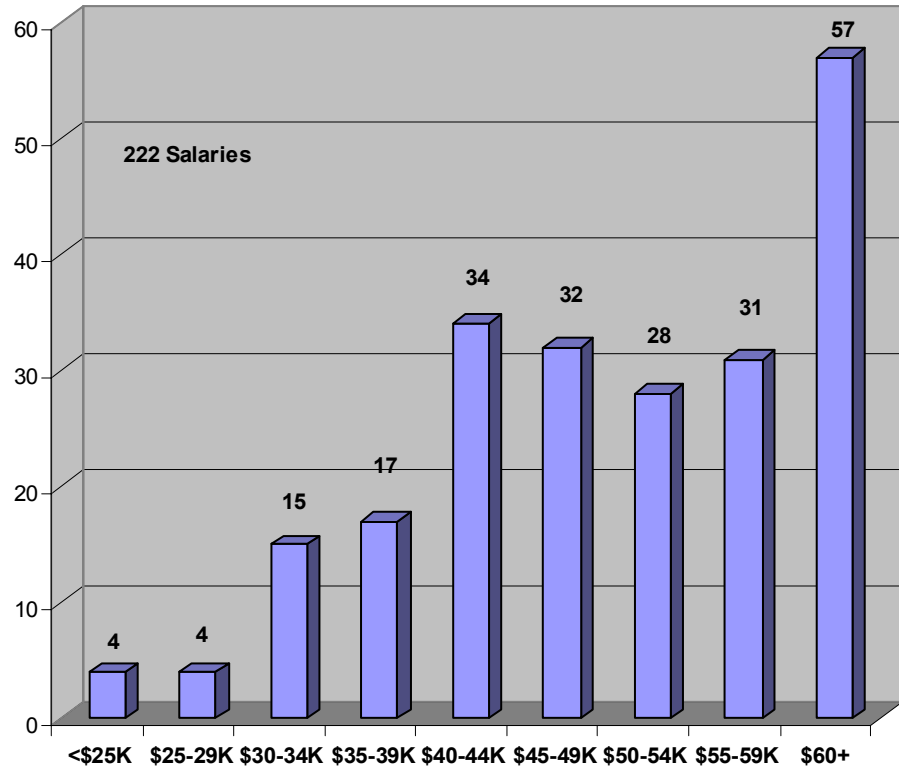
Geographical Placements by State

Salary Information

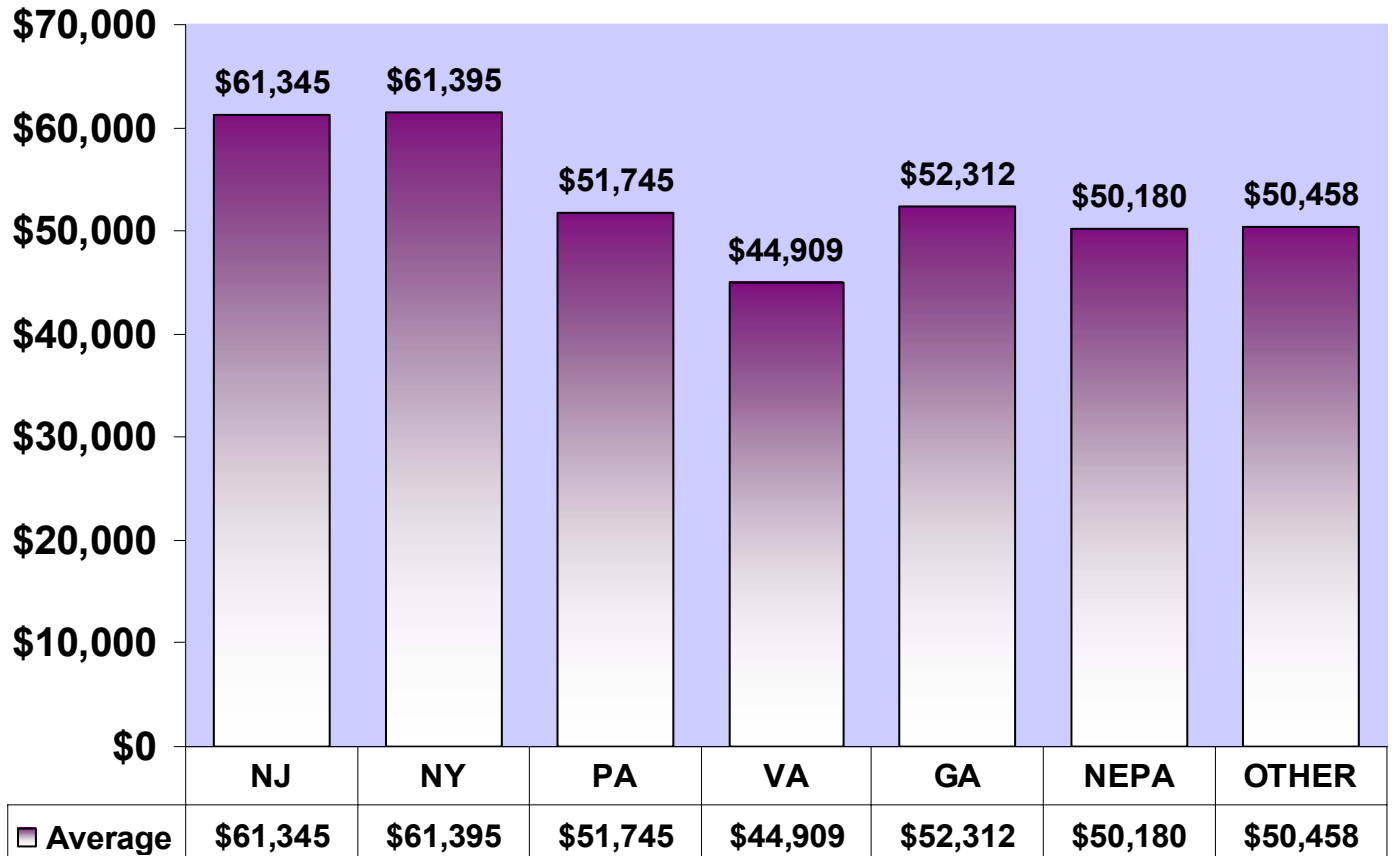

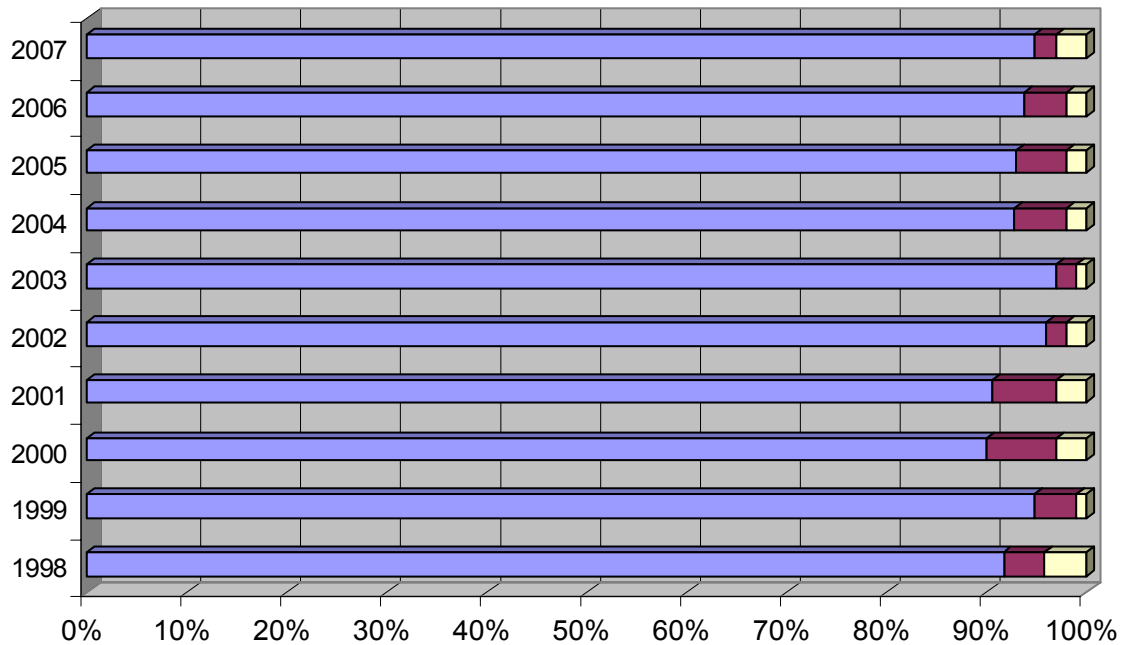
