

# POST-GRADUATION ACTIVITIES CLASS OF 2007

The Career Services Office conducts an annual follow-up survey of The University of Scranton graduates to determine the post-graduation status of this population. This four-page publication serves as an executive summary of the survey findings. Actual placements with employers and graduate or professional schools can be identified in a full report available in the Career Services Office.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2007 REPORT

- 901 students completed baccalaureate degree requirements in 2007
- 75% (N=672) of the Class of 2007 provided placement information
- 94.2% of the respondents were either employed or pursuing additional education full-time
- 58% of the respondents were employed full-time
- The average salary reported for 2007 graduates was \$41,168, a 4.8% increase from the previous year
- 78% of the graduates employed full-time were working in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York
- 36% of the respondents were pursuing additional education full-time
- The unemployment rate for the Class of 2007 was 2%

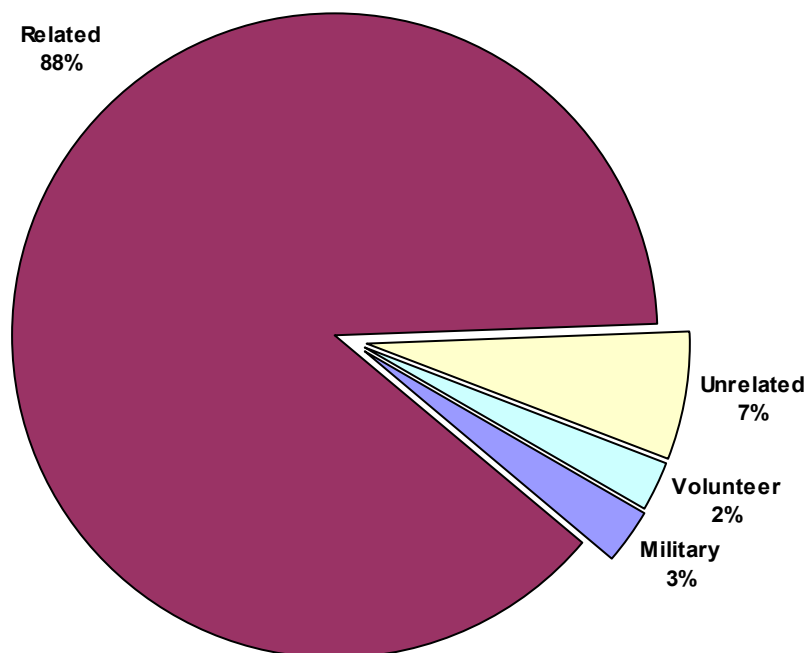
## **GRADUATES EMPLOYED FULL-TIME**

Of the 391 graduates employed full-time, 88% were employed in occupations related to their academic major and 78% were working in Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York.

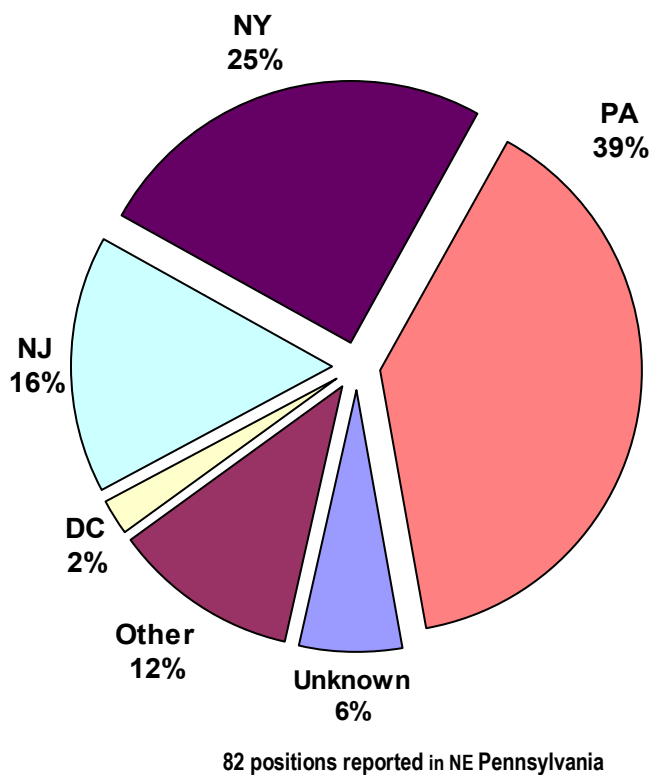
*Post Graduation Activities*



*Breakdown of Full-Time Employment*

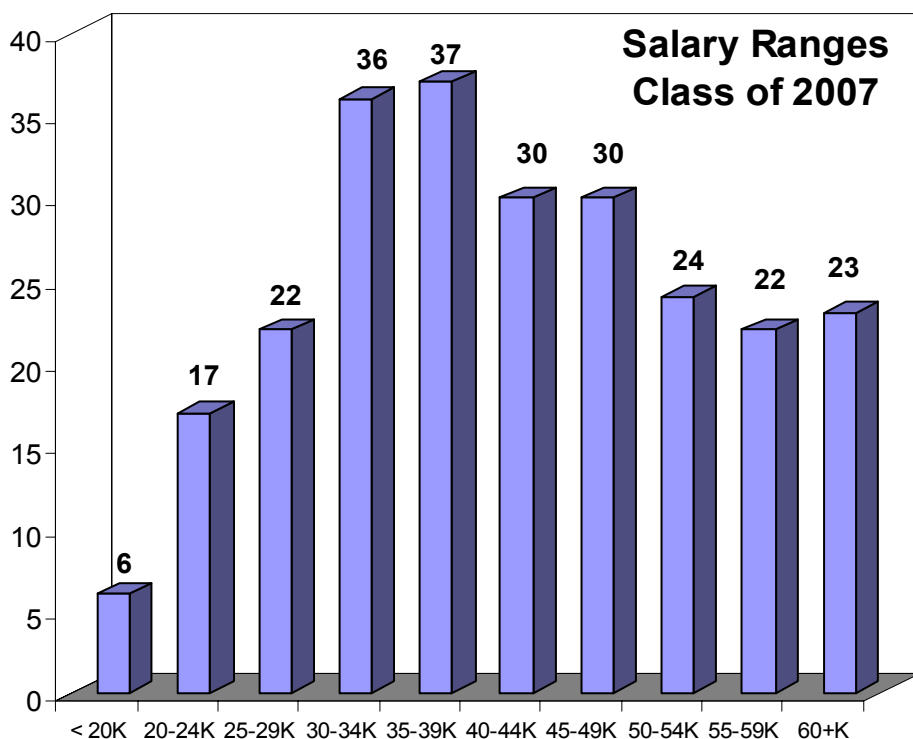


## Geographical Placements by State



## Salary Information

Approximately 63% of the graduates employed full-time provided salary information. The average salary for 2007 graduates was \$41,168, a 4.8% increase from 2006. Average salaries varied by type of job, location, and relatedness of work to academic preparation.



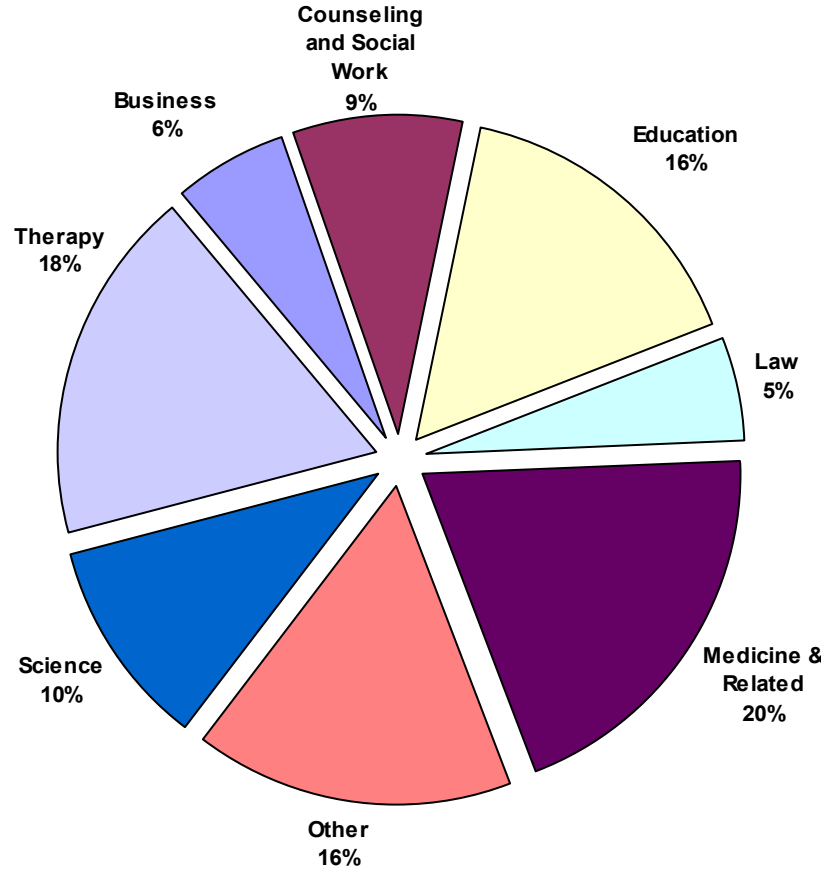

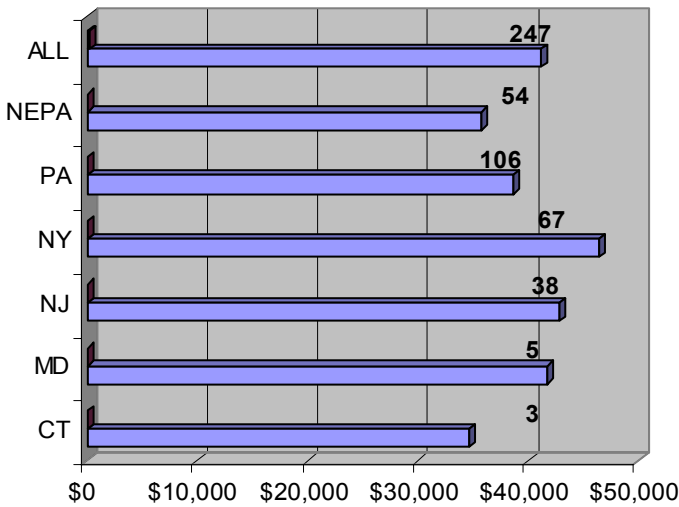
## GRADUATES PURSUING ADDITIONAL EDUCATION

Two hundred and forty two graduates indicated they were pursuing additional education on a full-time basis. Based on responses from graduates of the Class of 2007, 18% were enrolled in Therapy related programs, 20% in Medicine related programs, 5% in Law, 9% in Counseling / Social Work programs, 10% in Science related programs, 6% in Business programs, and 16% enrolled in graduate Education programs.

## GRADUATES PURSUING ADDITIONAL EDUCATION CLASS OF 2007

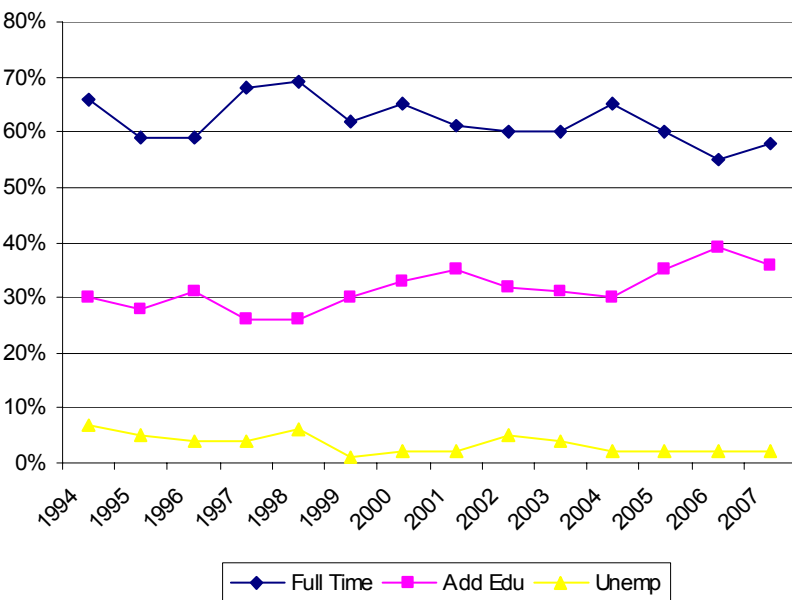


Class of 2007 - Salaries by State

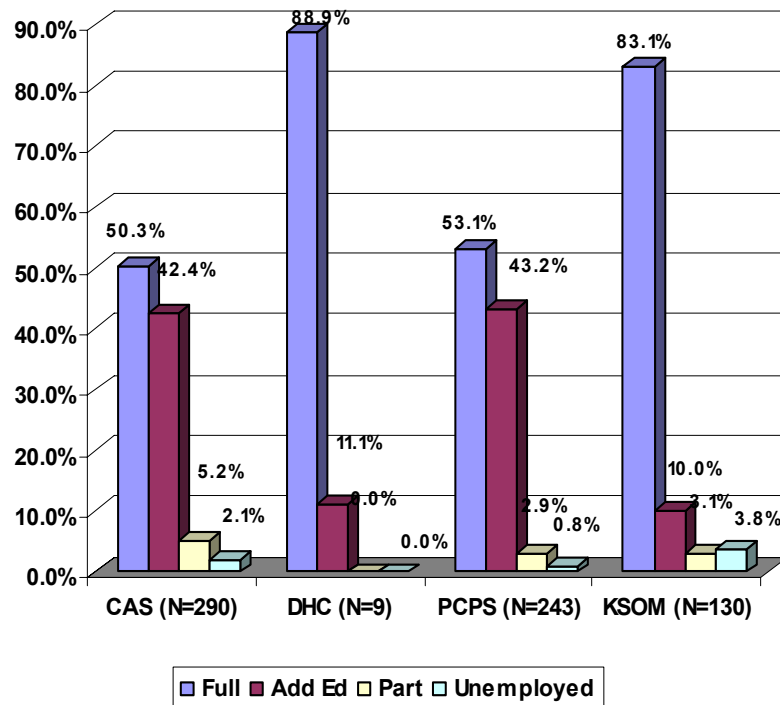
