CALL FOR PROPOSALS:

The faculty and staff of The University of Scranton and Marywood University are invited to submit proposals for projects to be funded by the Cooperative Grant Program. Proposals will be judged by the following criteria:

- Ability to foster communication and collaboration between/among faculty members of the two institutions
- Probability of forging strong relationships through shared experiences
- Ability to mutually enhance the schools' academic records and reputation
- Congruence with the missions of both institutions by providing seed funding for research, scholarship or practical applications related to the schools' service mission to the community

Proposals will be accepted from any discipline area. The awards may be used for research, clinical or service projects. Awards will be made to teams including both The University of Scranton and Marywood University faculty/staff members.

Awards will be made in late June; Funds will be available from July 1, 2009-June 30, 2010.

Range of awards: \$5000-\$10,000. In the past, 3-5 annual awards have been made.
